Activities have limited numbers and are booked on a first come first served basis.

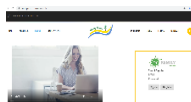
**Costs: Manly Village Public School Children \$67 per day & Non-Manly Village Public School Children \$72 per day**

## Booking Vacation Care

**Step 3. Double check the day you booked has gone from green to purple**



**To cancel** Open your purple day press the red cancel button at the bottom

**Enclosed shoes** that won't slip off or let them stub a toe



If coming to a themed activity, arrive dressed

## General Information

- Vacation Care hours are 7am - 6pm. Pick up after 6pm will incur a late collection fee.
- Breakfast is provided by MOOSH between 7am - 8am. Afternoon tea is provided by MOOSH between 3:30pm - 4:30pm.
- Staff to child ratios are determined by risk assessments and do not exceed 1:15. Individual staff to child ratios are displayed under each activity on the vacation care program.
- Risk assessments are available for programmed activities at the service on request.
- In order to process your booking, a current online enrolment must be completed for each child, including the Debit Success payment form.
- *No responsibility will be accepted for personal belongings or property brought to MOOSH.*
- MOOSH is a nut and egg aware service due to life threatening allergies. Please do not pack these.
- There is a 14-day cancellation policy for Vacation Care bookings. Fees will be charged for any cancellations made within the 14-day period.

Programmed activities have been selected on the basis of consultation and feedback from children, parents, staff and community members. The 'Accessible' symbol identifies activities suitable for children with breaks, sprains and mobility limitations. The "Weather Pending" symbol means an alternative onsite activity will be arranged in the event of wet weather. They are identified in the program using the following codes:
