# FROM THE OFFICE

### QUALITY AREA 7—GOVERNANCE & LEADERSHIP

Hello Families,

A reminder about COVID variants around the place and in lieu of what is occurring here and overseas:

Please be reminded that we will still be following our usual COVID safe practices in Term2.\*Health and Safety matters under COVID (when at MOOSH): Please be aware that we need to still be very cautious with self-hygiene and physical distancing. It will be good to teach and remind your child about coughing and sneezing into a tissue or into their elbow (and throwing the tissue into a bin). Hands need to be washed after this or if child sneezes/coughs into their hands.

If your child is ill—please do not bring the child to school/MOOSH.

If any member of your family is ill and your child attends school and MOOSH, please inform us especially if they display COVID like symptoms. Please get **TESTED asap**.

Explain to your child why we are not allowed to share food and drinks.

It is imperative they have their own water bottles—with their names on it.

If you are dropping off or collecting your child, please ensure you use hand sanitisers or wash your hands before using the Ipads.

Please remember to practise physical distancing with all the educators and children at MOOSH (unless it is your own child). And of course, keep the handwashing going very regularly! Stay safe all:)

WHS section—just a few trivia questions here for you:) —for better collaboration with families:-Are you aware that we have to complete risk minimisation forms for any medical conditions, food and other allergies, dietary requirements, even certain diagnosed behavioural conditions of children?

- -Did you know that you are responsible for updating your child's medical plans annually and risk minimisation plans if any changes occur?
- -Did you know MOOSH has a policy of no self –administration of medication by children? Ask Celine for more info on policy and procedures at MOOSH.
