### FROM THE OFFICE

Hello Families,

Yet again another lockdown for us! Please be reminded that we will still be following our usual COVID safe practices in Term 3 with a few additional mandatory processes in place.

Please be aware that we need to still be very cautious with self-hygiene and physical distancing. It will be good to teach and remind your child about coughing and sneezing into a tissue or into their elbow (and throwing the tissue into a bin). Hands need to be washed after this or if child sneezes/coughs into their hands.

If your child is ill—please do not bring the child to school/MOOSH.

If any member of your family is ill and your child attends school and MOOSH, please inform us especially if they display COVID like symptoms. Please get **TESTED asap**.

Explain to your child why we are not allowed to share food and drinks.

It is imperative they have their own water bottles—with their names on it.

If you are dropping off or collecting your child , please ensure you use hand sanitisers or wash your hands before using the Ipads. Please follow the directions of our MOOSH COVID Marshall during drop off and collection. Parents/guardians are not allowed to wander onto school grounds during this lockdown.

Everyone coming onsite to MOOSH will need to sign in on our QR code.

Families/Staff/ Visitors –are all REQUIRED to wear a mask onsite indoors and outdoors, unless you have an exemption.

Please remember to practise physical distancing with all the educators and children at MOOSH (unless it is your own child). And of course, keep the handwashing going very regularly! Stay safe all:)

MOOSH is OPEN for MVPS children for the BSC and ASC sessions --so even if your child is remote learning from home--you can still send your child to us during our sessions for some fun and laughter with the educators and their friends at MOOSH!
