MOOSH GOVERNANCE

Hello Families,

The children and staff practiced our Safety Drills this week and it helps with getting the children and staff emergency ready in case we have a lockdown or fire/emergency situation. This is also part of the Education and Care Services National Regulations which OOSH services fall under. The regulation requires us to have practice drills at least once every term and during vacation care (at least once in that period). We also have risk assessments for emergencies as well. We educate our MOOSH children on these emergency drills and on why we need to do them. We also educate the children on how to be safe in various situations and child protection is part of that education as well.

We aim to ensure all our MOOSH children understand the various aspects of safety in life.

DID YOU KNOW: OOSH services are assessed every few years by the Department of Education's Early Childhood Education and Care Directorate (ECECD) and we have about 40 National Standards to comply with under the Assessment and Rating process. If you would like to know more about this —please ask Will or myself .

At the last Assessment and Rating process our service received an Exceeding rating and we aim to keep that high standard and quality care as best we can.

OOSH services also get spot-checks from our regulatory body (ECECD) on a regular basis.

Other Information:

Please ensure that you have informed us of any medical conditions or medications your child requires for Term 2. It is imperative that we have all the correct medical /dietary information for your child before she/he starts at MOOSH. This is all part of our compliance as well.

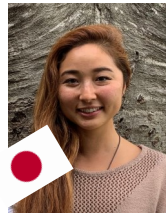

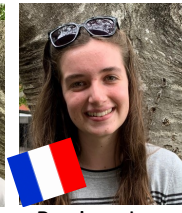

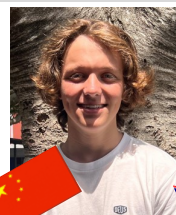
