

2026 Summer Vacation Care Program

All children can stay onsite or go on excursions, subject to minimum age and ability requirements as stated on each day. Children must only be booked into one roll each day they attend otherwise you will be charged twice for one day. Activities have limited numbers and are booked on a first come first served basis. There is a **28-day cancellation policy** for Vacation Care bookings. Please email info@manlyoosh.com.au if you would like to cancel Vacation Care bookings, cancellations cannot be made on the Xplor Home app. Please be aware that full fees will be charged for any cancellations made within the 28-day period. The cancellation needs to be made in writing at least 28-days before the actual booking. If you inform MOOSH within 28 days of the booking, you will not be charged.

Onsite / Incursion: \$85.00 per day Offsite Excursion: \$100.00 per day

Bookings for Manly Village Public School children should be made by **Friday 12 December 2025**. Places will be available to non-Manly Village Public School children after this date.

How to Book

- Step 1. If not enrolled at Manly OOSH, enrol online using a desktop at https://manlyoosh.com.au/enrol/
- Step 2. Wait for MOOSH to manage and confirm your enrolment (48 hours).
- Step 3. Xplor will send you a welcome email. Create an Xplor account using the unique link provided on your mobile.



Step 4. Make a booking using the Xplor Home app on your mobile.

It is your responsibility to check the booking has been made correctly in the bookings calendar. No exceptions will be made for errors

What to Wear

MOOSH hat is a must. Available for \$15 from the MOOSH office.



Sun safe clothing - make sure shoulders are covered.



Enclosed shoes that won't slip off or let them stub a toe.



If coming to a water or themed activity, please arrive dressed ready to go!

General Information

- Permission/Waiver Forms attached to this document need to be completed when making your online booking.
- Vacation Care hours are 7am 6pm. Pick up after 6pm will incur a late collection fee of \$30 each 15 mins.
- Children must arrive prior to the departure time listed individually on excursion days.
- Breakfast is provided by MOOSH between 7am 8am and Afternoon Tea is provided between 3:30pm 4:30pm.
- Staff to child ratios are determined by risk assessments and do not exceed 1:15. Individual staff to child ratios are displayed under each activity on the vacation care daily program.
- Risk assessments are available for programmed activities at the service on request.
- To process your booking, a current online enrolment must be completed for each child and the Debit Success
 payment form completed prior to your child attending MOOSH.
- No responsibility will be accepted for personal belongings or property brought to MOOSH.
- MOOSH is a **nut and egg free** service due to life threatening allergies. Please do not pack these in lunch boxes.
- There is a **28-day cancellation policy** for Vacation Care bookings. Please email info@manlyoosh.com.au if you would like to cancel Vacation Care bookings, cancellations cannot be made on the Xplor Home app. Please be aware that full fees will be charged for any cancellations made within the 28-day period. The cancellation will need to be made in writing at least 28-days before the actual booking.
- You are responsible for checking your bookings in the Xplor Home app.
